DEL BONITA rated in the second flight inside, lacked room on the turn then ran on late. SHE'S A GRINDER showed no speed, rallied while three wide and closed willingly. SATIN SWEEP rated in the middle of the pack, was in tight on the turn but faltered. CATIVATING LADY showed no speed and dropped back then passed tiring rivals. ROYAL AMELIA was void of speed and saved ground but made no rally. DEBUT DEB got off very slowly and showed no speed then was no factor. A JUNE AFFAIR was rushed up and set the pace, led to the turn then stopped.
