

OVER AND DONE WITH got off slowly and had a rail trip, split horses and closed belatedly. DRINK WITH PRIDE was void of speed, angled out and made a mild rally. DUBAI VICTORY was rushed up and set the pace then gave way in the lane. TOSS AND TURN wouldn't load into the gate, moved up while four wide and chased to the lane but tired. AIRTIGHT showed no speed and dropped back then was no factor. TARGET PRACTICE pressed the pace between horses, contended to the lane but faded.
