STAR OF PARADISE, in touch with the leaders in the opening stages, was reserved in hand to stalk just off the pacesetter while angling to the rail entering the first turn, continued under patient handling through the far turn, shifted out nearing the furlong marker while being prompted to advance, wrested command leaving the sixteenth marker and held REAL POWER safe to the end under firm handling. The latter was settled between foes in the last flight in the opening half, gathered momentum nearing upper stretch splitting rivals, shifted four wide racing into the stretch while being roused to challenge but couldn't gain even terms with the winner. U STEP ASIDE moved to the fore along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on narrow margin racing into the far turn, held sway past midstretch but yielded to the top pair in late stages while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. SANDIA CREST settled in the last flight along the inside in the opening half, shifted off the rail nearing upper stretch to bid between foes, was caught in tight quarters nearing the furlong marker but continued with interest to the end to make a mild gain. FIRE CLOUD settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was caught four wide entering the far turn while being prompted to advance but lacked a closing response. LETHAL, forwardly placed from the outset racing just off the pacesetter, prompted that foe racing into the far turn but came up empty nearing midstretch. COPUS tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages, lodged a brief bid three deep between foes on the second bend but came up empty nearing upper stretch.
