Footnotes

SLAMMY BOY, reserved in last near the inside racing to the far turn, was guided outside foes to circle into striking position racing four wide into upper stretch, wrested command in that path leaving the furlong marker and went clear under pressure. UNBRIDLED VICAR tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside from out of striking distance racing to the far turn, gradually gained contention entering upper stretch, then shifted out leaving the furlong marker to prove best of the others. TWYLAS RED CAT, in touch with the leaders while between foes racing into the first turn, was rated just off the first flight stalking the pace to the second bend, was urged to advance three deep on the far turn to challenge nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. TIMELESS FACTS joined the pace outside a rival racing into the first turn, forced the issue after a half to gain a clear advantage midway through the far turn, briefly resisted several challengers along the rail racing into upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. TEXAS HEDGE tracked the leaders outside a rival from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, then continued evenly between foes racing into the stretch. TIZ A SCHOLAR settled along the inside in the opening stages, shifted outside foes nearing the far turn to make some brief progress three deep between foes but lacked the needed final response. KERA'S KITTEN, a bit rank under light rating while gaining terms with several foes on the pace along the inside racing into the first turn, pressed the issue inside a rival to the far turn and gave way abruptly after six furlongs.
