Footnotes

LAVENDER DAN pulled his way to terms with a rival on the pace racing through the backstretch, shifted to the rail entering the turn after gaining a clear advantage, dictated terms to his foes along the inside to upper stretch and drew clear under firm encouragement. FOXY'S PLACE broke slowly, then was steadied in close quarters at the start, angled to the inside while steadily gathering momentum racing into the turn, altered course to the rail leaving the quarter mile marker and made steady progress to the end to prove best of the others. PISTOL PERSUASION, a bit restless in the gate before the start, settled out of striking distance while making his way to the inside racing through the backstretch, drew into contention while shifting out three deep nearing upper stretch, steadied momentarily in tight quarters racing into upper stretch but continued with interest to improve his position to the end while earning a share. SNOWKIN' GUN bobbled at the start, settled into stride outside foes in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position inside foes late. COOL THUNDER, unruly in the gate before the start, was urged to gain a position tracking the first flight a bit off the inside racing into the turn, was forced out four wide entering the stretch while steadying in traffic and had no further response. SCOOP DA LOOP was urged to gain a position outside a rival in the second flight, continued in that position while being fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded. XENA'S XEKE tracked off the second flight racing five deep through the backstretch and never gained contention. BOUND TO GOSSIP broke outwards bumping LAZYLOVIN, was collected off that foe to track the leaders along the inside, made brief progress inside foes racing through the turn, then raced erratically under pressure entering the stretch while giving way. LAZYLOVIN, bumped, then steadied at the start, settled along the inside and never gained contention. SMALL TOWN EMPEROR was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the outset, shifted outside the leader entering the turn while

making a second effort to challenge that foe but gave way abruptly in upper stretch. VALID DEVIL was a brief factor tracking the leaders off the second flight racing four wide into the turn but dropped out early.
