Footnotes

ST. LOUIE SLEW was urged along from the outset pursuing the pacesetter a bit off the inside racing into the turn and produced a steady late response to wrest command in the closing stages under firm handling. YOUR MOVE sprinted clear of her rivals while angling over to the inside, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin past midstretch but failed to sustain her momentum. MUNHALL MISS, bumped, then pinched back at the start, settled last to the turn, shifted outside foes racing into upper stretch gathering momentum, then shifted back to the inside racing through the final quarter while splitting foes and continuing with interest to gain a share late. MONGOLIAN FRONT broke inwards bumping MUNHALL MISS, was collected off that foe, then switched out tracking off the second flight racing to the bend, angled four wide racing into upper stretch but offered no closing bid. PINE LAKE angled to the inside early tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. MAGDALENKA broke outwards bumping MUNHALL MISS and never menaced thereafter.
