**Footnotes**

BIG TOM PRADO, carried out a bit racing into the first turn, was taken in hand correcting his course while being guided to the rail tracking behind the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a steady advance to contention inside foes racing into the far turn, shifted off the inside in upper stretch to split foes challenging for command and narrowly edged SECOND CORINTHIANS in time under firm handling. The latter broke readily to gain terms with a rival on the pace while drifting out entering the first turn, continued with a steady bid to force the issue racing through the far turn, took over to gain a clear advantage in upper stretch and resisted the winner to the end. AWAY WESTWARD, brushed at the start, was guided to the inside to track just off the second flight racing to the backstretch, made a steady advance on the leaders while shifting out three wide in upper stretch and continued willingly in that path to the end while just failing to match the top pair. ARCHYBDANCING broke inwards brushing AWAY WESTWARD, gained a position just off the leaders tracking those foes three deep into the backstretch as part of the second flight but lacked the needed closing response. PUTTINONASHOW was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the far turn, then gave way racing into upper stretch. PRADO U angled inside early tracking the leaders in second flight, shifted out racing into the far turn, was fanned four wide nearing upper stretch and quickly gave way. STEEL VICE, off step slowly, drifted out when held up avoiding close quarters racing into the first turn momentarily impeding the eventual winner and never gained contention. SOUL PILOT broke a step slowly, was settled into stride while working his way to the inside but never gained contention.
