MAWAAQEF, urged to secure a narrow advantage along the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace in hand racing into the bend, moved away to a clear advantage in upper stretch and steadily widened his margin under firm encouragement. EXOTIC WILDCAT, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter, came under pressure to prompt that foe nearing upper stretch, soon proved no match for that foe and just lasted for place honors. TIMOTHY TEN FOUR was guided to the inside tracking just off the leaders racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch and made some late progress to just miss for second. STRONG LUCK, reserved outside foes from out of striking distance early, made steady progress three deep on the turn, angled four wide racing into upper stretch and improved his position to the end. ENERGETIC SREVA, caught five wide in the opening stages, angled to the inside entering the turn racing behind the second flight but offered no closing bid. MARITIME MAN, outpaced in early stages, shifted off the inside racing into upper stretch but made no impression. COME ON MAN, caught three deep tracking the leaders as part of the second flight racing into the turn, steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. COVERT MISSION was never a factor. BEANSHADE broke in the air losing position to the field and trailed to the stretch.
