Footnotes

ENSORCEL took up a position along the rail racing within striking distance, tracked the leaders saving ground on the bend, shifted out three wide entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command and edge forward in late stages under firm left handed prompting. POCANELLA settled into stride near the inside racing to the bend, steadily gathered momentum while shifting outside foes midway through the bend, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and found her best stride late to close the gap and edge a rival for place honors. REALLY NOW, urged between foes soon after the break to secure terms inside the pacesetter, pressed that foe along the rail to upper stretch, couldn't contain the winner's bid and was just collared for second. RAILEY'S BLINKERS, held up out of striking distance along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out to split foes near the inside racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid between foes to late stages. HELLO HANNAH was hustled to the lead outside foes from the break, dueled for command outside a rival to upper stretch and gave out in late stages. JOZZI'S SPIRIT, caught a bit wide racing into the turn while settling well off the pace, angled out six wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. NABISCO CAT, between foes in the second flight early, worked her way to the inside entering the bend while tracking off the second flight but offered no closing bid. SAMI'S IN TROUBLE, caught five deep in the second flight in the opening stages, tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing through the bend, shifted four wide in upper stretch but steadily faded in late

stages. KANIJA urged along to gain a position between foes in the second flight, continued outside a rival on the bend and emptied out nearing midstretch. BABY NAVY was settled between foes early and never mounted a serious challenge. RUN DORA RUN was never a factor. BETTER SAFE dropped out of contention early.
