**Footnotes**

ACHAEMENES, urged to secure the lead near the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing to the bend, turned back a challenge from QUICK DELIVERY leaving the furlong marker and edged clear late under firm left handed pressure. The latter gained position inside foes in the second flight tracking the leaders, shifted out three wide leaving the midway point of the turn while being prompted to advance, moved to challenge for command nearing midstretch but proved no match. ALARMING AFLEET tracked off the second flight between foes in early stages, angled to the inside on the bend, switched out three deep in upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid while continuing well enough to earn a share. FUFTY TOO, held up just off the second flight along the inside racing to the turn, saved ground to upper stretch gaining some position and finished evenly in late stages. LEMON CUSTARD, reserved outside foes just off the second flight, made some progress outside foes on the turn, angled five wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final rally. TUCKY, allowed to settle along the inside early, never gained contention. HURTA angled inwards while gaining a forward placing to stalk just off the pacesetter in the opening half but steadily retreated midway through the turn. WELL EXCUUUZE ME tracked the leaders three deep between foes in the second flight racing into the turn and emptied out in upper stretch. DUMBLEDORE was a brief factor four wide leading the second flight on a narrow margin but was spent after a half.
