Footnotes

THE BEST OPTION was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, swung out six wide in upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. YOU'RE TOO WILD tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half, shifted to the rail nearing upper stretch commencing a steady advance to bid inside foes for command leaving the furlong marker and was just outfinished. RICHYSTHUNDERINGAL moved to the fore along the inside to dictate the pace on a narrow margin racing to the far turn, shifted off the inside racing through the stretch while being roused to resist several challengers but yielded to the top pair late. DONTBETELLINME tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing to the far turn, was urged to challenge while being fanned four deep between foes racing into upper stretch but continued willingly to the end while just missing for a share. TOP PAIR tracked off the second flight along the inside early, angled out racing into the stretch and gained some position while lacking the needed final bid. WINNING STAR angled to the inside early tracking the leaders in second flight, shifted out to bid between foes nearing upper stretch but came up empty leaving midstretch. WINSOCKIE tracked just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, was fanned three wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded between foes.
