PROPHET'S SONG sprinted clear of her foes while angling to the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace in hand on a comfortable margin through the turn, then was roused left handed through the final furlong to maintain her margin to the end. LAZEKA tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance inside a rival racing to the turn, shifted out to bid three deep between foes in upper stretch and proved best of the others while never gaining terms with the winner. DOROTHY Y tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly in that path while prevailing for a share. BLOND WARRIOR, urged along pursuing the pacesetter racing into the turn, chased that foe to upper stretch and came up empty leaving the furlong marker. QUEEN OF THE NILE was settled in last a bit off the inside racing to the turn and never gained contention while displaying some belated interest.
