Footnotes

ALL STORMY was rated just off the leaders along the rail stalking those foes racing into the backstretch, shifted outside the pacesetter entering the second bend while steadily moving to terms with that foe, wrested a narrow advantage nearing midstretch and held ICE CLIMBER safe to the end under firm right handed encouragement. The latter, reserved off the second flight saving ground in the opening stages, continued along the rail through the second bend, angled out nearing the furlong marker while being roused to advance, shifted out four wide in late stages but was cutting into the leader's margin to the end. DAKOTA DIGGER moved to the fore soon after the break to secure a clear advantage, dictated the pace along the rail to the second bend, resisted the winner's challenge racing through the far turn to midstretch but failed to match the top pair in the final sixteenth. CODE OF CONDUCT, held up off the second flight while angling inwards a bit to race between foes into the backstretch, continued between foes on the far turn while being urged to gain striking distance nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. MORE ANON, reserved off rivals while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, continued with an even effort just off the inside racing into the stretch. GALLANT EAGLE (IRE) was prompted to secure a forward placing just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, dropped off that foe racing to the backstretch to race as part of the second flight, was urged to lodge a brief, three wide bid nearing the far turn but quickly faded from contention. PRAIRIE BREEZE settled in last along the rail racing to the far turn and never gained contention.
