Footnotes

SON OF TIGER, never far back, tracked just off the first flight between foes racing to the backstretch under light rating, shifted out three deep nearing the far turn to press the issue, continued to force the issue outside a rival racing into upper stretch and edged clear late under firm encouragement. TSUNAMI KING, reserved off the second flight while shifting nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, switched out four deep leaving the midway point of the far turn while being prompted to advance and continued with a steady effort to close the gap while edging a rival for the place honors. GROOM tracked the leaders three deep between foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted to the inside nearing the far turn when presented an opening, continued with a steady bid racing into the stretch but finished evenly between foes in late stages while just missing for second. E. BLUE joined the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, duelled for command between foes racing through the far turn and weakened in upper stretch when failing to match the winner. NEXT KITTEN broke in the air losing position to the field, settled in last to the far turn, swung out five wide racing into upper stretch and made an

effort to improve position. CONDITION RED, reserved between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, continued evenly between foes just off the inside racing into the stretch. FRANK'S TIME, reserved off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, continued evenly while shifting out four wide racing into the stretch. LEMON CUSTARD, caught four wide racing into the first turn while under some prompting to gain a contending position, continued three deep in the second flight racing into the far turn but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. JOHNNY CADILLAC settled into stride along the inside racing to the backstretch but never mounted a serious challenge. RULEROUS was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the backstretch but gave way abruptly midway through the far turn. JOHNS LION was a brief factor tracking just off the first flight along the inside but was through after a half.
