**Footnotes**

WESTERN WOODS broke inwards exchanging come contact with WILL'S HONEY, was quickly righted to secure terms with a rival on the lead while in hand in the opening stages, went clear entering the bend while angling inwards a bit, then held sway on a clear margin to the end while under steady pressure in the final quarter. HANGER THIRTYEIGHT was urged to a forward placing inside a rival soon after the break, couldn't match terms with that foe after the opening quarter but continued well along the inside to prove best of the others. WILL'S HONEY, squeezed a bit between foes at the start, quickly recovered to track the pace between foes in the second flight, angled out racing through the stretch and continued with interest to save a share. SOUL COAXING, held up outside foes four deep in the opening stages, tracked the pace in that path just off the second flight racing through the bend, shifted five deep nearing midstretch and displayed some belated interest. GALLOPING GULCH broke outwards bumping WILL'S HONEY, was righted to track the leaders inside foes as part of the second flight racing into the bend but had no closing bid. AMBER'S SHORTY tracked the leaders three wide in second flight in the opening quarter but dropped out of contention early.
