### Footnotes

DELUXE HEIR, brushed by BLUES LEGEND in the opening stages while relinquishing the lead to QUEEN FOR LIFE racing into the first turn, was held up tracking the leaders along the inside racing into the far turn, shifted out of tight quarters leaving the furlong marker to bid three deep for command and drew clear under firm handling. CASS' LADY, reserved off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to terms with a rival in the second flight after a half, continued outside a rival on the second bend, angled four wide avoiding close quarters nearing midstretch and narrowly prevailed for second while failing to match terms with the winner. JANICE JONES, allowed to settle in hand in the opening half, shifted outside foes racing through the far turn, angled six wide entering upper stretch and found her best stride late to close the gap and earn a share. THE GARDENER tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight in the opening stages, pulled her way to terms with the first flight three deep entering the far turn, pressed the issue in that path to upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. BLUES LEGEND shifted inwards in the opening stages brushing the eventual winner, moved to gain terms with the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, prompted that foe to the second bend, dueled for command between foes into upper stretch and weakened leaving the furlong marker. RAQUEL was guided to the inside early to track off the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. LADY KITTEN was steadied out of tight quarters racing along the rail approaching the first turn, continued near the inside to the far turn but never seriously menaced. MOON, reserved along the inside in the opening half, never gained contention. QUEEN FOR LIFE moved to secure the lead while angling to the inside racing to the first turn, dueled for command racing through the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch.
