**Footnotes**

GIVERNY GIRL broke inwards bumping FUN STEALER, was collected off that foe to gain a position along the inside in the second flight, steadily advanced to striking distance inside foes racing into the turn, pressed the issue inside a rival to upper stretch, then edged away late while shifting out under pressure. LUNA VAN MAR broke inwards bumping GAIL'S JEWEL, was urged to gain a clear advantage dictating the pace a bit off the inside racing to the first turn, disputed the lead outside a rival racing through the far turn to upper stretch, but proved no match while lasting narrowly for place honors. LA PANCHITA, reserved between foes racing into the bend, angled five wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to just miss second. ANGEL DIVINE tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight in the opening half, advanced to contention racing four wide nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. COURTESY CALL, reserved near the inside in the opening half, drew into contention along the rail on the turn, awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, then came through tight quarters inside foes racing into upper stretch to improve her position late. FUN STEALER, bumped at the start, was collected to track between foes off the second flight, split foes racing through the turn but lacked the needed final response. DAISY AGAIN tracked off the second flight along the inside early, made some brief progress along the rail racing into the bend but came up empty nearing midstretch. SEA WHY, forwardly placed along the inside stalking just off the pacesetter, shifted three wide nearing the turn while making a brief bid but gave way nearing midstretch. I SEE MAMBO was settled along the rail in early stages but never gained contention. GAIL'S JEWEL, bumped at the start, was righted to track outside foes in the second flight, raced three deep between foes through the bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
