### Footnotes

MISH MOSH broke sharply to gain the advantage, attended a rival's pace racing under light reserve in the opening stages, steadily increased the tempo nearing upper stretch while edging forward to a narrow advantage, shook clear when given his cue nearing the furlong marker and widened his margin to the end under steady handling and a few right handed taps. BLUE CANOE, off last, settled off the second flight near the inside racing into the turn, swung out five wide nearing upper stretch and produced a steady late response to narrowly prevail for place honors. CAPTAIN JACK bobbed slightly at the start, was urged to dispute the pace while shifting to the inside, dueled through the turn to upper stretch, weakened when failing to match the winner leaving the furlong marker but continued with interest to the end to edge a rival for a share. SWEET LUCA tracked the first flight from just out of striking position racing three deep into the bend, continued in that path while moving to challenge nearing upper stretch, was roused to challenge between foes to late stages but lacked the needed final response. SAY SONNY tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out four wide to race between foes entering the lane but steadily faded from contention. BE BRAVE tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, was steadied in close quarters while nearest the rail midway through the bend and quickly dropped out.
