Footnotes

BABA LUCY broke readily to secure the advantage while shifting well off the rail in the opening stages, moved well clear of her foes entering the turn while angling to the rail, maintained a commanding advantage past midstretch and held safe the late charge of SHE'S AN ALPHA GAM to the end under firm right handed encouragement. The latter shifted inwards a bit while under light rating to track just outside a rival as part of the second flight in the opening stages, moved to split foes racing just off the inside leaving the quarter mile marker, produced a steady late response to draw on terms with the winner nearing the wire but proved only second best. ROSE MOUNTAIN angled to the inside early taking up a position just off the leaders in the opening stages, saved ground on the bend and continued evenly along the inside to late stages while earning a share. SISTER RESISTOR tracked off the second flight outside a rival racing through the backstretch, swung out five wide entering upper stretch and made an effort to improve her position. QUEEN OF SCIOTO, within striking distance three deep in the opening stages, continued in that path into the bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. AND HOW, reserved in the last flight along the rail in the opening stages, never mounted a serious challenge. BEYYA was urged to terms with the pacesetter between foes while prompting the leader's pace racing to the bend and gave way after a half.
