CAPE TOWN LASS lacked speed, moved up through traffic on the final turn, angled out in the stretch and prevailed in the final yards. GO GRACE GO raced close up just outside, took the lead between calls in deep stretch and just failed to last. ANEGADA raced three wide near the middle of the field, rallied in the stretch then lacked a winning bid. MISS SWEET TIME set the pace from the inside and weakened. CHANCEY LIGHT lacked speed off the rail and gained belatedly. PERFECT DEAR raced three to four wide and lacked a rally. LA LUNA DE ORO raced four wide and was not a factor. REPRIZED ANGEL raced close up inside and tired. CRAFTY SPIRIT raced inside but tired. RED LIFESAVER raced close up three wide and tired. THAWED was always outrun. PONETTE was never close. (Race run in lane 3, rail at 0).
