CURTAIN BLUFF raced close up three wide, rallied in the stretch and was along in time. SNUCK BY raced three wide near the middle of the field, rallied in the stretch and just missed. CARSE was reluctant to load, was shuffled back at the start, lacked speed and finished full of run. MANEKE set the pace from the inside and weakened. SEFAS GOLD lacked speed and improved his position. REVERENTIAL raced inside but weakened. KING OF CAPERS swerved in at the start, raced close up off the rail and gave way. DE HENNESSY was always outrun. COUSIN PAUL raced off the rail and gave way.
