J. PA raced unhurried inside foes from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, shifted out entering the turn while moving to gain terms with a rival in the second flight, angled three deep nearing upper stretch to challenge for command, then continued in an extended skirmish through the stretch, prevailing narrowly under firm handling. X MARKER, prominent outside foes from the break, forced the pace outside a rival into upper stretch, dueled between foes through the last furlong and proved second best. STREET CONTENDER tracked the leaders unhurried near the inside in the opening stages, made steady progress while angling out four deep nearing upper stretch and continued to close the gap on the top pair to late stages. DANCING ALKE moved from between foes to secure the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and weakened in the last furlong. STORM BOOT LARRY, on terms with the leaders along the inside in the opening stages, relinquished the advantage to a rival after the opening furlong, stalked just off the leaders along the inside to upper stretch, shifted out racing through the lane and made some mild progress between foes. CHURUBUSCO was settled off the leaders while making his way nearer the inside but never gained striking distance. ANGEL TALK tracked off the second flight outside foes racing to the bend, was caught four deep on the turn and offered no rally.
