Footnotes

SUCCESSFUL BID shifted out just after the break while coming under pressure to gain terms with several rivals in the first flight, disputed the lead inside a rival racing into the bend, gained a narrow advantage from that foe leaving midstretch and just maintained her edge to the end, gamely prevailing under firm right handed pressure. NAUGHTY AND NICE vied for command between foes from the outset, pressed outside a rival racing into upper stretch, forced the issue to the end and was just outfinished. TOO MUCH SUGAR, dropped off the leaders despite some pressure in the opening stages, continued under pressure inside foes racing into the bend, shifted off the inside in the final furlong and continued well enough to edge a rival for a share. DUNHUANG tracked just off the first flight four deep in the opening stages, angled to the inside entering the turn while gaining terms with a rival in the second flight, shifted out leaving the midway point of the turn to lodge a brief three wide bid but failed to sustain that effort through the final quarter. MY TAYLAUR SLEW tracked the pace unhurried between foes off the second flight racing into the stretch but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. PLEASED, reserved inside foes after bobbling a bit at the break, angled outside foes in the last flight racing through the backstretch but never gained contention. VICKY'S BAR, forwardly placed three deep from the outset, was eased off the first flight to track those foes racing into the bend, was fanned four wide after a half and steadily faded from contention.
