Footnotes

NEXT KITTEN broke awkwardly, raced unhurried outside foes into the first turn, worked his way to the inside entering the backstretch, made steady progress along the rail on the second bend to gain striking distance, shifted out leaving the furlong marker to bid four wide between foes and just edged FORBIDDEN FOREST on the wire under strong handling. The latter, held up out of striking distance three deep in the opening stages, made steady progress in that path racing into the far turn, angled five wide entering upper stretch, found his best stride late to challenge in tandem with the winner and was just outnodded. ICEE FIRE, forwardly placed three deep racing to the first turn, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight to the second bend, advanced to challenge three deep in upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker but was outkicked by the top pair. PESO exchanged bumps with TEACHEM OUTLAW at the start, shifted out after the break while under some pressure to gain a forward placing, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival into the far turn, bid for command between foes in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. BRATSY'S PIONEER tracked off the second flight along the inside into the backstretch, shifted out four deep in upper stretch and continued willingly to the end while not quite

matching the leaders. AFLEET PADDY settled along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch, then made some belated progress inside foes to improve his placing. E. BLUE settled between foes near the inside in the opening half, then continued evenly just off the inside racing into the stretch. FUN ON THE BAYOU, bumped by TEACHEM OUTLAW, then jostled between foes at the start, was reserved near the inside racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. BORA BORA BOY tracked just off the pacesetter inside a rival in second flight racing to the far turn but came up empty when called upon nearing upper stretch. U STEP ASIDE was urged clear racing into the first turn, set the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch and emptied out nearing the furlong marker. DANCE FOR PACO, reserved off the second flight along the inside, retreated steadily from contention on the far turn. TEACHEM OUTLAW exchanged bumps with several rivals at the start, was caught four and five wide racing through the first turn and dropped out of contention racing through the second bend.
