FEELS LIKE FLYING was prompted to secure the lead along the inside in the opening stages, dictated a measured pace on a narrow margin while in hand to the second bend, was roused to turn back several challengers racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. THREEFIFTYSEVENMAG raced outside foes off the second flight, was forced out avoiding traffic entering the first turn, was guided nearer to the inside tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and made steady late progress to prevail for place honors. LARRY ZIP, three deep between foes just after the start, was forced wide by ADENA'S CHANCE while impeding THREEFIFTYSEVENMAG entering the first turn, was forced out again nearing the backstretch avoiding DANGER STORM, continued outside foes in the second flight racing to the far turn, split foes three deep nearing the quarter mile marker while making some contact with DANGER STORM, couldn't gain terms with the winner and just lost second in late stages. MACHO COACH, reserved along the inside in last racing to the far turn, angled out entering upper stretch and split foes four deep in late stages to improve his placing. DANGER STORM gained a position along the inside just off the leaders, shifted out abruptly nearing the backstretch momentarily impeding STRONGEST LINK and LARRY ZIP, continued outside foes to make a brief, three wide bid racing through the far turn, was bumped approaching the quarter mile marker while being fanned four wide racing into the stretch and had no further response. ADENA'S CHANCE, between foes in the second flight, was forced out by STRONGEST LINK impeding several foes racing into the first turn, was urged to terms with the pacesetter three deep racing to the backstretch, forced the issue in that path to the second bend, couldn't match terms with the winner and gave way midstretch. STRONGEST LINK, a bit rank under firm rating in the opening stages, swerved off the inside forcing out several foes racing into the first turn, was forced out a bit again nearing the backstretch, was righted to track the leaders along the inside racing into the far turn, saved ground to upper stretch but quickly came up empty. JEDISCRETO was settled off the second flight along the inside early and never gained contention. CURFEW TOWER, forwardly placed stalking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, made a brief bid between foes midway through the far turn but came up empty entering upper stretch. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF DANGER STORM LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF LARRY ZIP WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
