Footnotes

TOP PAIR, reserved along the inside racing behind the second flight in the opening half, continued along the inside to the far turn, came through close quarters while shifting out nearing upper stretch, split foes three deep leaving the furlong marker and just edged ALLURING SQUALL in time under firm handling. The latter, held up off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, advanced to striking distance racing four wide leaving the far turn, moved to gain command between calls late but couldn't fend off the winner. LOHAN, reserved while angling inside early, pulled her way to contention between foes racing into the far turn, angled out five wide nearing upper stretch and continued willingly in that path to close the gap and gain a share. BAYOU TORTUGA, held up off the inside from out of striking distance early, gradually drew into contention while caught five wide leaving the midway point of the far turn, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch but continued with interest while just missing for a share. DELIGHTFUL DAISY sprinted to the lead racing to the first turn, set the pace on a clear margin to the second bend, was roused to hold sway to midstretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. IZIMOMO tracked just off the leaders along the rail in the second flight racing to the far turn but steadily faded nearing midstretch. COUNTESS VINDI tracked the leaders three deep as part of the second flight in the opening half, advanced in that path to make a brief bid between foes racing through the far turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. CAT BELLS was settled out of striking distance along the inside in the opening half and never gained contention. SECRET STORY (IRE) swerved out at the break, was settled into stride in last and never menaced thereafter. CATINATREE, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out entering the backstretch leading the second flight on a narrow margin, made a brief bid to challenge

between foes midway through the far turn but gave way abruptly in upper stretch.
