JUDITH'S LAKE was allowed to settle then angled six wide and made a steady advance to get up in time. CLASS ACK set the pace and dug in, battled but was outfinished. STUMBLING BLOCK stalked the pace and battled between but was outfinished. BUDDHA PASS got squeezed at the start, raced in the second flight, took up at the top of the stretch and altered course then made a mild bid while clear. JAYBIRD'S MIRACLE settled along the inside, had a rail trip but made no rally. MT. CRAFTY raced in the second flight, was asked while four wide and flattened out. KID GRINDSTONE broke sharply then dropped back and made no rally.
