BOOGIE RED led throughout, was not menaced with late while being much the best. CAPE KAROO raced close up off the rail earl, was no match for the winner but held the place. RAJULIE was void of early speed, exchanged bumps in the stretch then rallied for a share. DEAR FRIEND raced evenly and lacked a late response. TOO DIVINE broke inward and was taken up, exchanged bumps in the stretch while racing widest. JO'S FINALE was through early and failed to menace. ALEGRE BREEZE raced in the second flight inside, angled out in the turn, lacked room in the stretch and came up empty. RAILEY'S BLINKERS had good early speed and flattened out. RACE RUN IN LANE 4, 6 FEET OUT.
