JACKS AGAIN was off slowly, raced on the rail early, angled out in the second turn and got up in the final strides. CALIMONCO was never far back, swung wide in the second turn, had a late lead but was caught in the last steps. COSMIC KING had no speed, slipped through on the turn, veered out and bumped foe in the lane when making a late bid. DOCTOR BRASCH was slow early then blocked and altered course in the lane and was gaining too late. BIG BOY CHARLIE raced in the second flight inside, made a bid but was not good enough. SPECIAL HEART dueled to the stretch and gave way in the drive. SMARTEN DESTINY had a wide trip, made a middle move and came up empty. MONTY CAT dueled to the stretch then faltered heading for home. RUSTIC WAGON was through early and always back. RACE RUN IN LANE 4, 6 FEET OUT.
