Footnotes

SPANISH AMBASSADOR secured a forward placing outside a rival stalking just off the pacesetter racing into the bend, made steady progress to wrest command from that foe leaving the furlong marker, then edged forward in the final stages to prevail under firm handling. FINISH IN STYLE tracked the pace unhurried between foes racing behind the second flight early, steadily drew into striking distance while shifting out racing through the bend, angled four wide entering upper stretch and produced a solid late response to secure the place nearing the wire. SWIFT ACTION tracked just off and outside the second flight racing to the bend, advanced three deep on the turn to challenge for command racing through the stretch and continued willingly between foes to earn a share late. PI BELLA stalked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the turn, briefly awaited an opening nearing midstretch, shifted out three deep to continue between foes and was narrowly outfinished. PRAIRIE FEVER ducked inwards at the start, was quickly righted, then urged to the lead inside foes, set the pace on narrow margin into upper stretch and gave out late. TOP PAIR tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside to upper stretch but never gained contention. ROYAL GAMBLE, reserved three deep tracking off the second flight in the opening stages, angled inwards nearing upper stretch, momentarily impeding GAELIC LASS and had no final response. GAELIC LASS was settled off the leaders racing just off the inside in the opening stages, steadied out of close quarters leaving the quarter mile marker and never seriously menaced.
