BRAIN TEAZE worked his way to the inside in the opening stages gaining a position in the second flight racing just out of striking distance, made steady progress on the bend while shifting out nearing upper stretch, then continued with a solid late response to wrest command leaving the furlong marker, pulling clear late under firm encouragement. OFFICER LEX was settled outside a rival in the last flight early, gradually gathered some momentum while shifting out nearing upper stretch, angled out six deep in the lane and produced a his best stride late to close the gap and prevail for place honors. VOLTURI settled off the second flight off the inside early, made some progress to gain contention entering upper stretch, shifted out to bid five deep between foes nearing the furlong marker and was outfinished for second while finishing in hand nearing the wire once the issue was decided. TRIPLE OVERTIME tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening quarter, shifted four deep entering upper stretch while being roused to challenge but lacked the needed final response. CARL'S C NOTE was settled off the second flight along the inside racing to the bend and never gained striking distance. COMITATUS, urged to join the pace outside a rival from the outset, shook clear racing into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. GAVILAN was never a factor. THEWAYITUSEDTOBE flashed brief pace along the inside racing to the turn but stopped abruptly midway through the bend.
