PIRATES VOW sped to the lead along the inside under some prompting in the opening stages, shook clear racing into upper stretch and continued gamely to the end under right handed pressure to just maintain even terms with LIVE FROM APPOLLO on the wire. The latter, urged to secure a forward placing outside foes in the opening stages, made a steady advance racing three deep on the turn through midstretch and just gained even terms with the pacesetter on the wire to to finish in a dead heat for the win. HAPMAN was settled into stride off the second flight along the inside early, saved ground on the bend gathering momentum, shifted out in upper stretch while briefly awaiting an opening, then came through close quarters three deep to continue with a mild bid while prevailing for a share. ROARIN MISSILE tracked the leaders along the inside in the second flight, made some progress racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. SPEIGHT THE HALO tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the bend but offered no closing bid. TOO WILD FOR WORDS, prompted to secure a forward placing early, was eased off the leaders to track the pace three deep in second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded entering upper stretch. X MARKER went up to prompt the pace outside a rival racing to the turn but gave way entering upper stretch when proving no match.
