**Footnotes**

RIVRAV sped clear of the field soon after the break while being firmly rated in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch, then extended his advantage to late stages under firm right handed pressure. R STAR, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter along the inside racing into the bend, couldn't gain terms with that foe while shifting off the inside in upper stretch but proved best of the others. HAMMER JAMMER was settled off the second flight near the inside in opening stages, shifted out nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, angled five wide racing through the stretch and continued evenly while earning a share. PORT HUDSON, four deep racing just off the second flight early, angled inwards entering the turn to race outside a rival, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued with an even effort between foes to late stages. TEST MARKET, urged to secure a forward placing in the opening stages, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight racing into the turn but steadily faded from contention entering upper stretch. ESLA MAMBO, a bit slow into stride, raced along the inside to the bend, shifted out entering upper stretch to gain some position but made no impression on the leaders. GHETTO CAT, bumped at the start, worked his way to the inside tracking off the second flight racing to the bend, saved ground to upper stretch but lacked a closing response. JADE MAN hopped at the start losing position to the field and never menaced thereafter. GORDON BENNETT was outpaced early.
