Footnotes

MAGIC BULLET angled nearer to the inside while being reserved from just out of striking distance outside a rival in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance entering the turn, moved to wrest command three deep nearing midstretch, shifted inwards under pressure but drew clear late under firm handling. SWORD AND SHIELD broke outwards, was held up along the inside gaining a position in the second flight racing to the bend, shifted out entering the turn to split foes three deep advancing to contention, angled sharply to the rail in upper stretch to challenge inside foes but couldn't match terms with the winner. SPANISH BARON broke inwards, was collected to track off the second flight off the inside racing to the turn, made some brief progress racing four deep on the turn to gain contention nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid. HUCKLEBERRY BOY joined the pace three deep in the opening quarter, shook clear racing into the turn, set the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch while angling to the inside but gave way once headed leaving midstretch. BOOT TAILS broke slowly, was caught in tight quarters at the start, continued under reserve along the inside racing into the turn and never gained contention. LITTLE FEAT was settled off the second flight outside foes in the opening half and never mounted a serious bid. COURTESY TITLE, urged to dispute the pace along the rail from the outset, gave way racing through the turn. CROOK'S BODGIT vied briefly for command between foes racing through the backstretch but was spent after a half.
