Footnotes

GUADALCANAL, reserved from out of striking distance while shifting to the inside in the opening stages, steadily moved to terms with several foes in the second flight while nearest the rail racing through the backstretch, drew into striking distance saving ground on the second bend while remaining in hand, briefly awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted out to split foes nearing the furlong marker and was roused to wrest command and draw clear in time under steady handling. PHOENIX FORCE, reserved from off the second flight while shifting off the inside racing to the backstretch, made steady progress to circle into striking distance racing four wide on the far turn, moved to challenge in that path entering upper stretch but couldn't match terms with the winner. S S STEWBALL, bumped by JULIAN LOVE at the start, was collected while shifting outside foes to gain a position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady effort to advance three deep between foes racing through the far turn, struck the front in upper stretch but couldn't sustain his momentum through the last furlong. HUNGRY WILDCAT, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, saved ground to upper stretch, angled out to advance four wide while making some light contact with GARBURETOR nearing the furlong marker but continued with a mild bid. I'LL SHOW THEM, reserved in the last flight along the inside racing to the far turn, angled out six wide entering upper stretch and made some mild

progress. GARBURETOR broke a step slowly, raced unhurried outside a rival to the far turn, was caught four, then five wide racing through the far turn while being prompted to advance but lacked the needed late bid while being brushed nearing the furlong marker. CAJUN DIABLO sped to the fore while angling to the inside racing to the first turn, disputed the pace inside a rival racing into the far turn and gave way leaving the furlong marker. VIGILANTE LAW led the second flight off inside from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, but steadily faded between foes racing through the far turn. CALL TO GLORY, forwardly placed three deep racing into the first turn, tracked off the first flight racing to the second bend, then steadily retreated between foes racing through the far turn. JULIAN LOVE broke inwards bumping S S STEWBALL, pulled his way to terms with a rival on the lead racing through the first turn, pressed the issue into the second bend and gave out nearing the quarter mile marker.
