CULINARY raced three wide near the middle of the field, rallied in the stretch and drew off late. RUNWAY MODEL raced close up just outside and rallied for the place while no danger to the winner. KOTA lacked speed, came five wide into the stretch and gained belatedly. MARY ALEX set the pace inside and weakened. MY THREE SISTERS lacked speed and improved her position. BUBBLE N SQUEAK raced close up inside and tired. PATIENCE PAYS stalked the pace just outside and tired. QUEANSCO was through early.
