SPIVEY, a step slow into stride, was guided to the rail racing through the backstretch, made steady progress to gain contention after a half, raced a bit greenly in upper stretch, but continued inside foes to challenge for command in late stages and edged clear in time under firm right handed encouragement. FORTHECAUSE joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, pressed the issue into upper stretch while maintaining a narrow advantage but couldn't contain the winner's bid. RICHARD'S TUNE, forwardly placed inside foes from the outset, attended a rival's pace along the rail, dueled for command into upper stretch, shifted off the inside while continuing to dispute the issue but weakened in late stages while failing to match the top pair. COSMIC BREW settled in hand while shifting outside rivals racing through the backstretch, angled four wide in upper stretch and displayed some belated interest. LAFETER EVER AFTER, held up just after the start avoiding tight quarters, never gained contention. I MAKE THE RULES broke readily to gain a position racing just off the first flight stalking those foes racing into the turn but steadily faded entering upper stretch. A J MOON was hustled to contend between foes in the opening quarter and dropped out early.
