Footnotes

INTERCOMPANY LOAN broke readily to gain the advantage while shifting nearer to the inside racing into the first turn, moved clear dictating the pace in hand racing into the backstretch, steadily widened her advantage nearing upper stretch and extended the margin in late stages under firm hand urging and a few right handed taps. GOTTA DANCE, reserved saving ground racing to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance inside foes nearing the far turn, continued to gain position along the rail racing into the stretch but was only second best. DECISIVE ACTION, forwardly placed three deep tracking just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, continued in that path through the far turn to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response while prevailing for a share. VOL DU VENT settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the backstretch, continued evenly off the inside into the stretch gaining some position but made no real impression. THE NAZGUL RIDE stalked just off the pacesetter along the inside early, shifted out midway through the backstretch to prompt the leader racing into the second bend but quickly came up empty. DUBAI MAGPIE settled saving ground racing to the backstretch and never gained striking distance. TOCCATINA tracked just off the first flight well off the inside racing to the backstretch and dropped out of contention early.
