SIMPLY GOOD was rated stalking just off the first flight along the rail racing into the backstretch, steadily drew into striking distance while continuing under patient handling nearing upper stretch, switched out of close quarters entering the lane while being roused to challenge outside the pacesetter and gained the advantage in time under firm handling. BEE HOME SOON moved to the fore along the inside to dictate the pace on a narrow margin, continued with a steady response to turn back a rival racing into upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge past the furlong marker but came up second best. LIME TRYST, reserved in the last flight along the inside in the opening half, saved ground throughout but continued with interest to improve position nearest the rail while edging a rival for a share. TAPNFIRE tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening half, was urged to lodge a bid three deep between foes racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. CRACKING GOOD PINS settled three deep between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance while shifting out five wide, then four wide to challenge nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. CHICA BONITA settled between foes in the last flight early, was fanned five wide between foes racing into upper stretch while gaining some position late but made no real impact. LUCIA BUNS, caught four wide in the last flight early, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch while proving no threat. SUGAR KATE, forwardly placed three deep tracking just off the leaders in the opening half, made a brief bid between foes racing through the far turn but emptied out early. PASSPOST TO PARIS, in touch with the pacesetter between foes in the opening stages, prompted the pacesetter racing into the second bend and gave way abruptly after six furlongs.
