### Footnotes

STAR OF CLASS, off a bit slowly, was settled in last along the inside racing to the turn, shifted out nearing upper stretch to split foes just off the inside and produced a steady late response to wrest command in time under firm right handed encouragement. SHOWBIZ IS MY BIZ was prompted to gain terms with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, pressed that foe racing through the turn, edged forward to a clear advantage leaving the furlong marker while shifting to the rail but proved no match when confronted by the winner. HOT HEAD, pulled his way to position between foes with the first flight in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders to track those foes in second flight outside a rival racing into the turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch while being roused to advance and displayed some late interest to earn a share while being outkicked by the winner. RIO CHAMA tracked off the second flight outside foes racing through the backstretch, was fanned four wide racing into upper stretch but continued with a mild bid in that path to late stages. CHANTILLY OUTLAW broke sharply, shifted to the inside to dispute the pace racing into the turn, dueled into upper stretch and gave way leaving the furlong marker. THINKING SHOWBIZ tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance inside a rival in the second flight for a half and steadily faded racing into upper stretch.
