Footnotes

PIRATES VOW sped to the lead outside a rival in the opening stages, dictated the pace on his own courage racing a bit off the rail entering the bend, continued to hold sway throughout and came under some right handed prompting late to maintain the advantage. HARVEST HOME settled into stride along the rail racing just out of striking distance, gathered momentum while shifting out three deep near midstretch and made steady late progress to close the gap while edging a rival for place honors. PETERS ROCK secured a forward placing racing just outside the pacesetter in the opening stages, pursued that foe under pressure racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady bid while being outfinished for second after appearing to jump some tracks leaving the furlong marker. SHEDROW HERO angled inwards to track just off the first flight under light rating racing through the backstretch, was urged to advance on the leaders while shifting out four deep nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. BARRACUDA BAY settled outside a rival in the last flight racing to the turn, swung out five wide entering the stretch but failed to make an impression on the leaders. TORO GRANDE, forwardly placed along the rail stalking just off the pacesetter, was roused to challenge inside that foe racing into upper stretch but came up empty in late stages.
