Footnotes

UNO PECADOR moved clear under some prompting while shifting to the inside racing through the stretch in the opening quarter, opening a commanding margin on the backstretch, turned back a challenger racing through the far turn to regain a formidable advantage and held sway to the end under pressure. SHOOT THE LOOP, reserved in the last flight while making his way to the inside in the opening half, shifted out splitting foes racing through the far turn, angled four wide in upper stretch and produced a steady late response to prevail for place honors while closing the gap. LAYTHATPISTOLDOWN tracked off the second flight a bit off the inside under rating to the far turn, made steady progress racing between foes through the stretch and was just outkicked for second while edging a rival for a share. IVER WITH AN E, reserved between foes well off the second flight in the opening half, made steady progress while shifting out three deep in upper stretch and continued willingly between foes in that path while just missing for a share. DOCTOR TROTTER, reserved between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, swung out four wide racing through the far turn while being urged to advance and continued outside foes in the stretch while making an effort to improve position. CAPTAIN MARVIN tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight for five furlongs and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. CHAS THE MAN tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight, was prompted to briefly challenge the leader racing into the far turn and flattened out nearing midstretch when failing to match that foe. AFLEET PADDY settled into stride along the inside in last racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. EL TRUENOS tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half and steadily retreated from contention on the far turn. IDEAL ALLUVIAL tracked the leaders racing three deep off the second flight in the opening half and dropped out nearing upper stretch.
