JOANIES BELLA raced close up well off the rail, rallied to challenge in the stretch, took the lead between calls in deep stretch and just lasted over BRIEF BLISS. BRIEF BLISS also raced well off the rail while near the middle of the field, responded to urging in the stretch and did not miss by much. FIRST AGAIN trailed to the stretch though not far back, angled out in the stretch and rallied belatedly but could not reach the top two. VICKI VALLENCOURT was void of early speed and improved her position in the drive. DON'T RUFFLE ME vied for the lead just outside and weakened in the drive. LEEWARD CITY lacked speed while saving ground, made a bid to contention in the stretch and faltered late. MISS INDIANA contested the pace inside and tired. LEMON HAZE raced close up three wide and tired. GLENBRIAR GIRL was always outrun.
