Footnotes

DOMAIN'S RAP, reserved outside a rival tracking off the second flight in the opening half, was roused to advance midway through the turn while shifting three deep nearing the quarter mile marker, moved to challenge in that path in upper stretch, then took charge and drew clear under strong handling. DEVILS TOWER angled inwards to track the leaders outside a rival as part of the second flight in the opening stages, commenced a steady, three wide advance on the turn to challenge for command racing into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but proved best of the others. BE BRAVE, held up tracking the pacesetter within striking distance in the opening stages, moved to press that foe racing into the turn, duelled for command between foes into upper stretch but weakened when failing to match terms with the top pair leaving the furlong marker. FUN ON THE BAYOU broke slowly, settled a bit off the inside, angled four wide while moving to contention nearing the quarter mile marker but lacked the needed final response. WILD COMMAND, held up a bit off the inside in the second flight in the opening stages, was urged between foes to contend racing through the turn but came up empty in the drive. HOTROD STICK, allowed to settle along the inside early, saved ground throughout but never gained contention. SOUTHLAND JAZZ hopped at the start, was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing to the bend but gave way nearing upper stretch.
