Footnotes

FIRST TRUMPET broke sharply, gained a position outside a rival tracking the leaders within striking distance while under light rating racing to the turn, angled three deep nearing upper stretch while being prompted to challenge, struck the front near the furlong marker and edged clear late under firm handling. I AM THE SHERIFF broke slowly, settled into stride along the inside racing to the turn, angled out six wide in upper stretch and made steady progress between foes late to prevail for place honors. RED ALL OVER angled inwards gaining a position between foes off the second flight, was carried out a bit momentarily impeding CROWN OF ARAGORN nearing the bend, continued with a steady advance outside foes on the turn to challenge five deep entering upper stretch, ducked out sharply under left handed pressure nearing midstretch, then righted his course in late stages while being outkicked for a share. LITTLE SHEIK went up to prompt the pace outside a rival from the break, gained a narrow advantage on the bend, set the pace into upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. MY MAN MORAN settled outside foes racing off the second flight, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch and made some belated progress. CHIPCO tracked just off the leaders inside a rival in the second flight, shifted out nearing upper stretch to bid between foes, then shifted inwards a bit in late stages while failing to sustain his momentum. HOODWINKED worked his way to the rail in the opening

stages tracking off the second flight under some reserve, briefly gained contention inside foes entering upper stretch, was checked out of tight quarters approaching the furlong marker, then was steadied along between foes to late stages while failing to regain contention. CROWN OF ARAGORN tracked the pace racing three deep behind the second flight early, was forced wide racing into the turn and never menaced thereafter. OLD EXCHANGE, reserved off the second flight along the inside early, ducked out nearing the turn crossing into the path of RED ALL OVER, was collected off that foe to track a bit off the inside racing through the turn but steadily faded racing into the stretch. CLOCKER BOB, urged to a forward placing along the inside, pressed the leader on the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. GRAY was never a factor.
