Footnotes

STHEKIN gained a position between foes just off the first flight in the opening stages, was steadied in close quarters while shifting out a bit entering the first turn losing some position, continued outside a rival off the second flight into the backstretch, made a steady advance to contention three deep on the far turn, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while being roused to challenge, wrested command leaving the furlong marker and edged away while drifting out under pressure in the closing stages. NIFTY SHINDIG settled well off the second flight while angling to the inside racing to the backstretch, swung out five deep entering upper stretch and made steady progress to the end to close the gap while proving best of the others. ROARINGOODMARTINI, unhurried in the opening stages, raced three, then four deep while being prompted to gain terms with the first flight racing through the first turn, drew on terms with the pacesetter after the opening quarter, prompted that foe racing into the second bend, edged forward to a narrow advantage in upper stretch but couldn't sustain her momentum. SUGAR STREET angled to the inside to gain a position just off the first flight racing into the first turn, stalked the leaders under rating into the second bend, shifted out in upper stretch while being urged to advance while racing in some close quarters but lacked the needed final kick. AMERICAN LIGHTS angled to the inside to track off the second flight racing to the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn but never gained contention. FLEET CLASSIC moved to the fore soon after the start to dispute the lead, dictated the pace on a narrow margin a bit off the inside racing through the backstretch, dueled for command on the far turn and gave way leaving midstretch. NEED A REASON, in touch with a rival on the pace in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders entering the backstretch to track those foes outside a rival to the second bend but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. WHAWAYTOSTARTADAY broke tardily and trailed throughout.
