A Supplementary Nomination of \$500 may be made on Wednesday, September 19, 2012, which includes entry and starting fees. Original nominees to pay \$100 to pass the entry box and an additional \$100 to start, with \$65,000 Added; after payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. WEIGHTS: Three-Year-Olds 118 lbs.; Older 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; \$35,000 or \$20,000 twice in 2012, 5 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) This event will be limited to fourteen (14) starters. Highweights preferred. Preference of horses of equal weight will be Highest Total Earnings in 2012. Failure to draw into this race at time of entry cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by usual time of closing. Two (2) horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single ownership interest. Nominations Closed Wednesday, September 12, 2012 with 14. (S)

Footnotes

THIRD CHANCE was urged to secure the lead inside foes soon after the break, dictated the pace on a clear margin racing into the turn, steadily extended her advantage racing into the stretch and widened her command to the end in a ridden out effort. SIR APPLESOLUTELY tracked the leaders outside a rival in the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to split foes racing into the turn to briefly challenge the leader, couldn't gain even terms with that foe but continued with interest to prove clearly best of the others. HOODWINKED tracked the leaders inside a rival in second flight, saved ground to upper stretch but offered no closing bid. SMILING GAMBLER settled out of striking distance racing well off the inside early and never gained contention. VAN DEMON flashed brief pace outside the eventual winner but retreated from contention early.
