MONTANA KID, reserved between foes racing off the second flight in the opening half, steadily drew into contention shifting out four wide on the far turn, ducked out bumping QUIETDETERMINATION racing into upper stretch but continued with a steady late response to narrowly prevail in time following a prolonged drive. INTERNALACCOUNTING tracked just off the first flight along the inside under rating racing to the far turn, made steady progress to challenge along the rail when presented an opening in upper stretch, struck the front between calls late and was just outkicked. YANKEE DEALER tracked just off the first flight racing three deep into the first turn, continued to track the leaders outside a rival on the backstretch, was urged to challenge three deep racing into upper stretch but couldn't quite match terms with the top pair. LEMONADE KID, reserved along inside in the last flight racing to the backstretch, swung out seven wide entering the lane and made some belated progress. QUIETDETERMINATION settled between foes near the inside racing to the backstretch, shifted out five deep leaving the midway point of the far turn while under prompting to advance, was bumped by the eventual winner when moving to challenge outside that foe racing into upper stretch losing some position and lacked the needed late response. MING GLO worked his way to the inside early, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out nearing the furlong marker and continued evenly three deep between foes to late stages. PIRALU moved to the fore while angling to the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a narrow margin into the second bend, duelled a bit off the rail racing into upper stretch but gave out leaving the furlong marker. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN gained a position stalking the pacesetter in hand racing to the backstretch but came up empty when prompted to advance racing into the stretch. SCORE BABY SCORE was settled outside a rival from well out of striking distance and never seriously menaced. SAAR, bumped at the start, trailed the field into the stretch. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF QUIETDETERMINATION LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER WHICH WAS DISALLOWED.
