Footnotes

CARROLL CO. KID was urged to secure the lead while shifting to the inside soon after the start, dictated the pace on a narrow margin inside foes racing into the bend, continued in an extended skirmish past midstretch while losing the advantage but produced a solid second effort in the final sixteenth to regain the lead in time under brisk right handed encouragement. FRIENDIAN, reserved four deep in the second flight racing through the backstretch, was urged to challenge three deep entering the turn, pressed the issue to late stages while striking the front between calls late but couldn't fend off the winner's final bid. MOST DISTINCT, in touch with the pacesetter in early stages racing three deep on the backstretch, was urged to press the issue between foes on the turn into upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker and was just outfinished. HIGH'R VOLTAGE, bumped at the start, was righted to gain a position three deep in second flight tracking just off the leaders in the opening half and continued with an even effort off the inside racing into the stretch. SLEW CITY SIN broke readily, ceded the lead to the eventual winner to stalk that foe along the inside in second flight, was steadied repeatedly racing into the turn while very rank under restraint, continued inside foes through the turn and steadily faded racing into the stretch. BRIMMERTON shifted off the rail early while gaining a position between foes in the second flight, was eased back out of close quarters then shifted out racing through the turn but offered no rally. SING ME AWAY broke outwards bumping HIGH'R VOLTAGE, was quickly righted to gain terms with the pacesetter racing between foes but steadily retreated entering the turn. SERRATED EDGE was never a factor. HOWARD WHO, off a bit slowly, was roused to contend in early stages but lacked response.
