BALLADO'S BABY raced close up off the rail and lacked a winning bid. LORRAINE lacked speed and improved her position in the drive. ROYAL BANDITA raced close up off the rail and weakened. FACCIA BELLA lacked speed then gained steadily to the stretch but faltered late. LITTLE MO was always outrun. PRAIRIE SPRING set the pace from off the rail and tired. ERIN G. raced close up but gave way after a half.
